### The Role

- Q&A of incoming materials such as timber, board, veneer etc.
- Q&A of completed work before it goes into finishing.
- Ensuring that all components are included in the joinery items before handed over to Goods out/finishing.
- Brief handover to finishing and any queries addressed.
- Completing personal work to a high standard.
- Identifying any delays/problems that occur/might arise and reporting them to management.
- Actively providing/seeking solutions to issues and providing remedial advice.
- Taking Toolbox talks and recording attendance.
- Reporting any plant issues to management.
- Reporting any maintenance issues to management.
